Would you like to help create the future of public transportation in Vancouver? Alliance for Community Engagement (ACE) has a one hour discussion with transportation planner Eddie Montejo and Vancouver City staff **next Wednesday, November 16th, at 11 a.m.** Please join us!

This is an informal session where we will get an overview of the Vancouver Transportation System Plan (TSP) and have a chance to ask questions and give input on the plan's recommendations, strategies and draft transportation networks as the process moves forward.

The City of Vancouver is seeking feedback on the future of transportation in Vancouver. It is offering an "Online Open House" to share information on the current draft, which includes **a survey for feedback. Please take the time to fill out this survey on the TSP at (<https://www.beheardvancouver.org/tsp>)**. The survey will form the basis for projects and programs that the City will eventually invest in.

"The TSP is still underway – the plan will help guide transportation decision investments in the City over the next 20 years. As of Summer 2022, the City has made progress on the TSP by drafting 'Big Ideas' for the plan as well as drafting transportation networks. This open house summarizes this recent work and will ask for your feedback to help shape the plan's recommendations and strategies as the process moves forward."
