CarbonWA's I-732, a revenue-neutral carbon tax, on the 2016 Washington state ballot. This is modeled on the successful carbon tax passed in Vancouver BC. CarbonWA needs help for Phase 3 of the campaign. If I-732 passes, Washington state will have the strongest price on carbon in the U.S.
